Important Instructions

- 1. Students must regularly check their attendance status on MOODLE and also with their class coordinators. Those not having attendance as per the RGPV, Bhopal norms will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- 2. The students must check the institute website and department webpage, regularly, for updates.
- 3. Students are expected to submit all the weekly assignments and appear for all weekly online quizzes for assessment of their continuous evaluation.
- 4. Students must attend "Additional Classes" conducted by the faculty for clearing the doubts and discussing other academic issues, as per need.
- 5. For each student, it is compulsory to appear in two mid semester examinations. The mid-semester marks will be awarded by taking the average of two mid-semester examination marks.
