Important Instructions

1. Students must regularly check their attendance status on MOODLE and also with class coordinators. Those not having attendance as per the RGPV, Bhopal norms will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
2. Students are expected to submit all the weekly assignments and appear for all weekly online quizzes for assessment of their continuous evaluation.
3. For V semester students it is compulsory to register (free) for one NPTEL course under the Self study/Seminar course available in the scheme. However, appearing in the exam and earning a certificate is not mandatory.
4. For all VI & VII semester students it is compulsory to register and appear for proctored examination for NPTEL courses as part of Departmental Electives, Minor Specialization /Honours, as approved by their respective departments / BoS and as mentioned in their scheme. Earning a certificate from NPTEL is mandatory for passing in that course.
5. In VIII semester, students who aspire can go for full semester internship in an approved industry/research organization etc. For details, the “Internship Policy” available on the website can be referred. There is also a course on professional development which is evaluated based on the participation/achievement of students in extra & co-curricular activities during the tenure of their B.Tech. course
6. All the students (wherever applicable) are required to submit all online assignments of NPTEL courses and appear in online examination in order to secure a minimum pass grade. If they do not abide, they will be treated as failed in these courses (opted under Departmental Electives, Minor Specialization /Honours etc., as per the provision of scheme). For details they can contact their respective SWAYAM coordinators. The on-line examination for NPTEL/SWAYAM courses will be on 18th, 19th and 20th December, 2021 as per the present notification from NPTEL.
7. From V semester onwards, there is a provision to opt for two (02) additional credits, in order to get an Honours/Minor Specialization. The additional courses can be selected from the NPTEL platform (from the list of courses approved by the department/BoS for each semester). For details, the Class Coordinators / HoDs can be approached.
8. For each student, it is compulsory to appear in two mid semester examinations. The mid-semester marks will be awarded by taking the average of two mid-semester examination marks.
9. Students who fail in previous semester courses are expected to attend Special Classes for remedial purposes.
10. Exam fees will be deposited during Registration but it does not mean that the students are eligible to appear in the examination unless the RGPV requirements are fulfilled.
11. Mid semester exam-III will be conducted only for those students who could not appear in previous mid-semester tests due to valid reasons and who have taken prior permission from the Class Coordinators & HoD.
12. The students whose results are not declared/not eligible for year promotion and applied for revaluation/Challenge case are required to provisionally register with the Class Coordinator with the undertaking that if they fail, their provisional registration may be treated as cancelled. Attendance during the period of provisional registration will be counted for fulfilling attendance requirements.
