Sub: Internship Opportunity in Canada for B.E.-III year students of MITS Gwalior

Students of MITS Gwalior are eligible under TEQIP-III scheme to grab the Internship Opportunity in Canada under the collaboration of MHRD & M/s Mitacs, Canada.

Mitacs is a Canadian national not-for-profit founded in 1999, dedicated to driving innovation through research and skills training. Funded by the Canadian Government and working with 60+ universities and over six thousand companies, Mitacs has supported more than 14,000 multi-disciplinary research collaborations.

Since 2009, Mitacs has accepted more than 1,000 students from India alone to initiate sustainable research collaborations.

In the academic years of 2017-18 and 2018-19, **MITACS will select 200 Indian Students per year** for their research work at Canada.

The students selected by MITACS shall be funded by MITS and expenditure shall be admissible under TEQIP-III scheme. Mitacs will synchronize the research areas of selected Indian Students with the one available at Canadian Universities.

The interested students have to apply online on Mitacs globalink well before the **deadline: 22nd Sep, 2017.**

- **Submit application directly to the MitacsGlobalink Research Internship program** on the Mitacs website and application portal to be eligible (**<https://globalink.mitacs.ca/globalink/index.html>**).
- 1. **Student Eligibility:** Senior undergraduate students from (preferably 5th to 7th semester) engineering streams(B.E. & M.Tech as well) , enrolled fulltime in MITS.
- 2. **Students will go to Canada during the period of May to June in 2018 and will stay back for next 12 weeks.**
 - To apply, students must provide:Transcripts for all completed undergraduate coursework
 - CV
 - At least one reference letter and
 - Expression of research interest
- 3. The program is competitive and in addition, students are evaluated on a combination of factors including their academic records and skills appropriate to the projects. Students must:
 - Have a minimum grade **point average of 8.0** to apply to the program and Completed the age of 18
 - Demonstrate oral and written fluency in English or French, Select at least three(3) and no more than seven (7) projects from at least (3) of Canada's provinces and/or territories and
