Intellectual property refers to inventions, literary innovations and artistic works, symbols, names and images used in commerce. It is divided into two categories; Industrial Property and Copyright. Industrial property includes patents for inventions, trademarks, industrial designs, geographical indications etc whereas copyright covers literary works, films, music, artistic works and architectural design. Hence, to protect the intellectual property, rights related to intellectual property must be followed and maintained legally. These rights allow creators, or owners of patents, trademarks or copyrighted works to benefit from their own creations. Intellectual property rights are outlined in Article 27 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, which provides for the right to benefit from the protection of moral and material interests resulting from authorship of scientific, literary or artistic productions. Intellectual property rights needs to be promoted in order to create and invent new works in the areas of technology and culture and legally protected to encourage the commitment of additional resources for further innovations. Keeping in view the above issues, this workshop has been organized which will cover following topics:

 - The value of patent
 - Designs, Trademark and Copyright
 - Identifying patentable ideas and Filing Process
 - Design identification of IP and invention disclosure
